A haiku is an unrhymed 17 syllable poem.
The structure is:

- Line one—5 syllables
- Line two—7 syllables
- Line three—5 syllables

Try writing a haiku about managing our natural resources.
Here are three examples to get you started.

Trapped

River full of weeds
Stops flowing into the sea
Poor fish caught up stream

Hungry

Empty drink bottles
Soup tins and pizza boxes
Food for recycle bins

Erosion

Wind whips up the dust
Floods wash away the best soil
Paddocks left lifeless
