

Application for review of local government decision

Parts 4 and 5, Chapter 3 of the *Land Protection (Pest and Stock Route Management) Act 2002*

Applicants or holders of a stock route travel or agistment permit can apply to the Department of Environment and Resource Management (DERM) for a review of the local government's decision if they are not satisfied with a decision to:

- refuse to grant or renew the relevant permit
- impose conditions on the permit
- refuse to amend conditions on request
- cancel the permit.

To apply for the review, complete this form and send it to one of the regional offices listed at the end of this application.

The application should be received by DERM within 28 days of receiving the local government's decision. You should receive notice of the outcome of the review within seven days for a stock route *travel* permit, and 14 days for a stock route *agistment* permit.

- review notice
- decision and the reason provided
- original application.
