

Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised Entry Prohibited

Protection of cultural resources

Entry to the Massey River Area, KULLA (McIlwraith Range) National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) (see map) is restricted to protect significant cultural resources.

The restriction enables the Umpila clan and Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) to protect and manage the cultural values of the area.

A person, other than an acknowledged Aboriginal person from the Umpila clan, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from QPWS. For further information, phone 13 QGOV (13 74 68).

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units

On-the-spot fines apply.
