Gondwana Rainforests of Australia World Heritage Area

Expression of Interest for Queensland Members



The Queensland Government is appointing five members to the Community Advisory Committee (CAC) for the Gondwana Rainforests of Australia World Heritage Area (Gondwana Rainforests WHA) for a three-year period. The Gondwana Rainforests WHA is primarily managed by the NSW Department of Environment, Climate Change and Water's National Parks and Wildlife Service and the Queensland Department of Environment and Resource Management's Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service.

The role of the CAC will be to advise the Gondwana Rainforests management committees and federal and state ministers on matters relating to the identification, protection, conservation, presentation and management of the Gondwana Rainforests and to enhance community participation and consultation.

The CAC will comprise members representing conservation, indigenous, commercial, tourism, recreation, and local government interests.

Selection for members will be based on the candidate's:

- familiarity with, and demonstrated interest in, the Gondwana Rainforests
- demonstrated experience in representing the interests of their stakeholder group
- familiarity with Australia's obligations under the World Heritage Convention.

Expressions of interest based on the above selection criteria are invited from suitably qualified individuals.
