5. Specific Obligations of a recycled water provider

1.	Meet Specific water quality criteria as outlined in the Public Health Regulation 2005 and the guidelines, if any.
2.	Immediately give the regulator notice if there has been a change in the circumstances under which an exemption was granted. This will enable the regulator to amend (or if necessary cancel) the exemption. For example, if the recycled water provider proposes to supply water for a new use the provider must notify the regulator using the Notification of change of circumstances form.
3.	Prepare and submit an annual report to the regulator for each financial year after an exemption has been granted. Refer to the guidelines, if any for additional information on annual reports.
