START WHEN 2000 MEGALITRES PER DAY PASSING KOLAN RIVER BARRAGE, CEASE WHEN LESS THAN 1000 MEGALITRES PER DAY PASSING KOLAN RIVER BARRAGE

Class 1H Start 875 ML/day at Silverleaf Weir. Cease less than 200 ML/day at Ficks Crossing GS or its replacement

Class 1J Start 500 ML/day at Litzow's GS. Cease 432 ML/day at Fick's Crossing GS or its replacement

Start 500 ML/day at Litzow's GS. Cease 432 ML/day at Fick's Crossing GS or its replacement.

Class 1L Start when 345 ML/day passing Derra Gauging Station. Cease when less than 86.4 ML/day passing Derra Gauging Station.

Class 2L Start when 700 ML/day passing Derra Gauging Station. Cease when 345 ML/day passing Derra Gauging Station.
